

Thesis Title	:	Acquiring for the Prime Minister in the Parliamentary System of Thailand
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## ABSTRACT

Acquisition of the position of Prime Minister in the Parliamentary System of Thailand arises from the votes of the Parliament's members who contain the rights to vote against their parties and the rights to transform, according to the Amendment to the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand B.E. 2540 and the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand B.E. 2550. These reasons cause the conflicts and schisms, affecting on the stability of the government, as the obstacles in government administration and country's development under the leading of Prime Minister for the admiration to the Parliamentary System and Democratic Regime.

After the study, the author finds the situations in Thailand that the Parliament's Members voted against the majority of their parties and transformed to other parties as opposed to Democratic Regime and broke the code of conduct. These situations lead to the conflicts between the Prime Minister, the parties' policies and the people's expectation, which cause the problems on corruptions. Together with the weak Prime Minister and parties, the political activities have no unity. Therefore, the amendment of related Articles in the Constitution and laws would be required.

The author proposes 2 solutions: firstly, to amend the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand B.E. 2550 Article 172 and 173 by presenting the candidate for the Prime Minister who can be either the leader of the political party who gain the majority of the members in the House of Representative or the leader of the political party who can form the government to His Majesty the King for the Royal Command. Secondly, to amend the provisions of the organic laws concerning the Political Party and the Constitution of the Kingdom of B.E. 2550, Article 65 Paragraph 4 by voting for the position of the Prime Minister by Members of Parliament according to the resolution of their political parties without the right to refer the Constitutional Court for its decision.
