Citation

Ms. Nootrudee Siriboon obtained both her Bachelor of Science in Food Science and Technology degree in 1980 and her Master of Science in Food Science degree from Kasetsart University in 1991. She joined Assumption University in 1994 as a faculty member of School of Biotechnology. She was appointed as the Chairperson of the Department of Food Technology in 1996 and had served the position for several terms. In 2003 she was awarded the St. Martin de Tours Award for Excellence in Performance, Third Class.

Ms. Nootrudee is a dedicated lecturer. She has been teaching several subjects for more than twenty years. As the former Chairperson of the Department of Food Technology, she was responsible for program management and she developed two programs during her term and at present, she assists the current Chairperson in managing the programs.

As a teacher, she has devised techniques to make her students understand difficult concepts and has utilized various strategies in teaching and managing her classes. She believes that giving her students regular quizzes and assignments is beneficial to the knowledge development of her students. Moreover, whenever possible, she makes herself available for them to ask whatever problems they may have regarding the lessons or personal matters.

Besides her teaching duties and responsibilities, she has also acted as senior project advisor for more than fifty projects covering food science and technology and product development areas. These senior projects are actually the research each student has to conduct before graduation. It requires creation of idea, planning well and execution, collection of data and analysis before conclusion and writing a scientific report. With her help as an advisor, the students can accomplish their research works successfully.

An exemplary lecturer in the School of Biotechnology, she is a good role model for her colleagues in terms of hard work, honesty, and loyalty to the School and the University. Because of these qualities, she has been appointed as a member of the School quality team since the beginning of the quality assurance system in the University. Moreover, she has also served the University as a member of the University Planning and Budgeting Committee and Internal Quality Assessment Committee.

Ms. Nootrudee has contributed not only to the intellectual development of her students but also to her own academic development. She has written several research

articles and academic papers which are either published in journals or presented in conferences. Two of her recent publications are: “Product Development of Thai Style Curry Scones”, a full-paper presentation and Product Development of Banana-in-Coconut Milk Ice Cream, a poster presentation at the International Conference on Sustainable Global Agriculture and Food Security 2014, Bangkok, Thailand, July 16-18, 2014
