Dr. Subhavadee Numkanisorn received her B.Ed. in Thai Language at Srinakarinwirot University in 1980. She earned two Master's degrees, one in M.Ed in Thai Language in 1990 and the other in Philosophy in 1996 from Chulalongkorn University.
