READING

Reader: From the first letter of Paul to the Corinthians (15:20-26)

From Paul's vigorous lecture to his converts (First Corinthians), we read from Paul's teaching on the Resurrection. Similarly, Mary's Assumption demonstrated victory over death through the risen Christ.

Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. Death came through a man; hence the resurrection of the dead comes through a man also. Just as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will come to life again, but each one in proper order: Christ the first fruits and then, at his coming, all those who belong to him. After that will come the end, when, after having destroyed every sovereignty, authority, and power, he will hand over the kingdom to God the Father. Christ must reign until God has put all enemies under his feet.


