ABSTRACT

This research is to study a legal measure to protect informal workers in Thailand that spread across country in parts of agriculture, fisheries, industries and commercial. Most of them are freelance workers and do not registered a in working system. This research clarifies with the issue for protect such workers in agriculture, fisheries and home working.

It is found that at present Thailand does not have legal measure to protect those workers relating to welfares, benefits, labor practices and minimum wages under the labor protection law and lead to impacts with the legal measure to protect the informal workers in various fields. While in foreign countries, both of developed country and developing countries have a law to protect the informal workers. Some countries have a specific law to protect the informal workers separates from the labor protection law.

The researcher has proposed solutions by issue the specific law to protect the informal workers in part of the agriculture, fisheries and home working.
