Dr. Jirapun Daengdej is one of the active researchers of ABAC. While doing his Ph. D. study at the University of New England, Australia, one of his publications received the "Best research paper aware" from an International Conference in Knowledge-Based Systems held in India. Upon completion of his Ph. D., he also received a scholarship from the University of New England to continue Post-Doctoral Research. During his Post-Doctoral work, he received another "Best Research paper award" from an International Conference which was held at Oxford University, UK. Both of the papers after presentation, were invited to be published in a journal of the UK.

In total, he has published more than 30 papers in both proceedings and journals. This year, he has also been invited to submit a paper to a conference in Italy where only invited authors are allowed to submit their papers. In the past, examples of invited authors include the president of Stanford University, and professors from UCLA, Berkeley. During the past 3 years at ABAC, he has also been invited to be in reviewing committees for journals in USA, and various International Conferences such as the International Conference on Intelligence Agent Technology' 2001, and 7th Pacific Rim International Conference on Artificial Intelligence'02 held in Japan. His 2 latest research papers have been accepted into the IEEE Aerospace Conference to be held next March at NASA.

Dr. Jirapan's research has brought great recognition to the Faculty of Science and Technology and to ABAC, and thus he is awarded the St. Hilaire Award for Academic Writing (3^{rl} Class).
