Thesis Title: A COMPARATIVE STUDY ON STUDENTS' SATISFACTION BETWEEN NAUNG TAUNG MONASTIC HIGH SCHOOL AND KYAUK TA LONE PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN SOUTHERN SHAN STATE, MYANMAR

The purpose of this study was to compare the students' satisfaction towards the school instruction, course, grading, test, guidance, rules, library, and assistance between Naung Taung monastic high school and Kyauk Ta Lone public high school in southern Shan state, Myanmar.

A total of 135 students from the two schools were surveyed. The main source of the data was a set of questionnaire that investigated students' demographics, and students' satisfaction. The collected data were analyzed by using the descriptive statistics including Frequency, Percentage, Mean, Standard deviation; and inferential statistics of Independent Samples t-test (Two-tailed).

The study found that the students' satisfaction at both schools were *high*. The research also found that in general there was no significant difference of students'

satisfaction between Naung Taung monastic high school and Kyauk Ta Lone public high school in southern Shan state, Myanmar. However, significant difference of students’ satisfaction towards course, grading, test, rules, and assistance were also founded in two schools.
