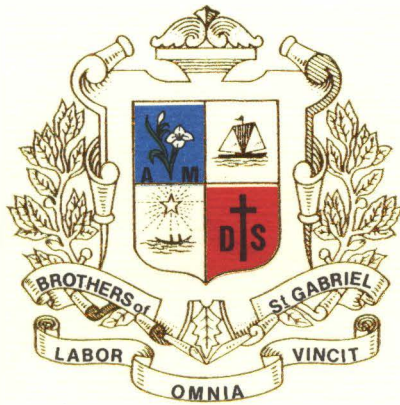

AU AWARDS FOR EXCELLENCE

Philosophy and Objectives

“Those who have sacrificed their lives and time by their creative loyalty and positive contributions to the institution must be recognized, promoted and rewarded.” So wrote Rev. Prathip Martin Komolmas in the *Faculty and Staff Development Policies*, July 22, 1993.

The philosophical underpinnings of the AU Academic Awards were simply that good deeds and achievements must be recognized and awarded. The President had often expressed his wish to establish academic awards as incentives for the academic community. Evaluation of job performance for this purpose was undertaken. After a considerable length of time, the administrators decided to introduce the awards. These awards aim to both reward for past performances and encourage future efforts. As a reward, it demonstrates our belief that those selected have met and surpassed the standards of excellence for the award given. The awards are also meant to encourage future efforts of not only the reward recipients but others who may take note that they, too, will be recognized for superior performance. The AU Academic Awards are granted periodically to those who met the selection criteria.

Historical Background

One of philosophies of Assumption University is that good deeds and achievements done by any member must be recognized and awarded. The first conferment of awards was initiated in **1997** under the name **AU Academic Awards**. Only lecturers were nominated for these awards under six categories. Then, three-tier system of achievements (first, second, and third class with the first as the highest in each category) was announced in 1999 to take effect in 2000 (Au Academic Awards, December 24, 1999, p. 12). In the year 2000, the name of the awards was changed to **Au Awards for Excellence**. The purpose is to reward not only teaching staff but also the non-teaching staff who daily facilitate in the management and operation of the institution.

So far the awards committee is chaired by the President with Brothers in the University administration serving on the committee (Au Academic Awards, December 24, 1999, p. 12). The sole right and prerogative on selection of the awardees reside in the committee.

THE SIX AU AWARDS

Each award was named after an illustrious person found in Catholic Church history and also in memory of our predecessors who had worked long and hard to carry out their teaching mission. The general policies governing each award were laid down by the AU Academic Awards Committee in 1997. These policies are subject to review, re-interpretation and modification as may be called for. Except for the St. Montfort Award, the awards are given in three classes. The second and third class awards are meant to recognize mid-level and junior AU faculty and staff who have performed well above the norm as compared to their peer group. The awards are as follows:

St. Montfort Award Illustrious Service Award

The St. Montfort Award was named after St. Louis Marie Grignon de Montfort (1673-1716), the founder of the Brothers of St. Gabriel. He is our spiritual master who walked before us toward the Living God. Following in his footprints, we can proceed on a path to union with God. The Brothers of St. Gabriel in Thailand consider him to be a model for a religious life and for their educative mission.

This award is given for faithful, dedicated and outstanding services rendered to the University by senior administrators whose career spans more than 25 years.

St. Michael Award Public Service Award (First, Second, and Third Class)

The award was named after St. Michael the Archangel, the protector of the people of God.

This award also honors the name of Brother Michael, one of the 13 French Brothers who moved from Thailand to India during World War II. He was appointed master of novices at Eachinkadu, Yercaud, South India, tasked with the training of a number of senior Brothers of the Province of Thailand.

The award comes in three classes and is given to University members who have provided academic and/or other significant services to society, and who have represented the University in academic and supporting activities that are acknowledged by the public. In so doing, they uphold and promote the University's reputation and stature.

St. Hilaire Award
Distinction in Writing Award
(First, Second, and Third Class)

This award was named after St. Hilaire who was born at the beginning of the fourth century at Poitiers in France. He was a bishop and Doctor of the Universal Church.

Brother Hilaire was one of the first five pioneering Brothers to arrive in Thailand in 1901. He was a well-known educator at Assumption College, Bangkok. He mastered the Thai language so well that he became an unparalleled Siamese Linguist. He wrote Thai language manuals; the first of which, *Darun Suksa*, was considered by all as the very best source for the learning of the Thai language.

The award comes in three classes and is designated for those who achieved distinction through academic writings in the form of articles and books.

St. Martin de Tours Award
Excellence in Performance Award
(First, Second, and Third Class)

St. Martin de Tours, for whom St. Martin de Tours Award is named, was a Roman soldier raised in Italy. Finding God, he converted to Christ and became an unwilling soldier. Later he was a disciple of Hilaire of Poitiers and, still later, became the Bishop of Tours.

The award was also named in memory of Brother Martin de Tours, one of the five Brothers who first entered Siam on October 20, 1901.

This award is designated for lecturers and administrators: who discharged their duties and responsibilities conscientiously and superbly: who exhibited high standards of efficiency, excellence and quality in teaching, counseling, and duties such as composition of test materials, framing of examination papers and other academic related factors.

The award is also for non-teaching staff who add to the University learning process.

**St. Bernard Award
Special Merit Award
(First, Second, and Third Class)**

The award was named after St. Bernard (1090-1153), an abbot and later named Doctor of the Church. He was a Cistercian monk. He wrote profusely and movingly concerning the Lord Jesus, spirituality, the Scriptures, and the Blessed Mother.

The award also recognized Brother Bernard Mary whose idea of adding a degree program to the existing Assumption Commercial College (ACC) program that eventually led to the establishment of ABAC and hence Assumption University.

This award is intended for University members: who exhibited special managerial skills; and who performed their tasks and assignments beyond the normal calls of duty such as initiating, restructuring or reengineering of programs for an office or department, or providing voluntary services for improving, upgrading systems and procedures, and participating in other artistic or scientific activities for the welfare of society.

**St. Thomas Aquinas Award
Research Award
(First, Second, and Third Class)**

The award was named after St. Thomas Aquinas in respect for his special talents that he devoted in full measure to the search for the Eternal Truth.

St. Thomas Aquinas was a great Dominican teacher (1225-1274). He traveled and wrote extensively. His two *Summas* should not obscure his other biblical, theological and philosophical writings. He dedicated his brilliant talents to the investigation of the sublime truth of God in the light of faith and the human intellect. He is the patron saint of all Catholic schools.

This award is given to those who contribute through their research to the promotion, enhancement or the reputation and prestige of the University. Their research should result in publications, patents and/or other innovative materials or feature.

Report

Rev. Bro. President:

It is an honor that you grace the conferral ceremony for Au Awards for Excellence 2005.

The Au Awards for Excellence is held annually to recognize outstanding faculty and staff members for their achievements, dedication, and good deeds.

Prior to the awards conferment, I would like to present an update on the University's efforts to upgrade its faculty and staff members' qualifications for the achievement of excellence through quality and competence. These efforts are part of the strategies that the University undertakes to retain its leading position amidst intensified competition in the education arena.

I. Human Resources

Part of the University's strength is in its diverse, qualified and competent Human Resource. Currently, the University has 1,178 faculty members doing either or both academic and administrative duties, 299 of whom are Ph.D. holders, while 689 and 190 are master degree and bachelor degree holders with the ratio of 16 : 59 : 25 respectively. From the total, 834 members are Thai nationals and 344 members are foreigners coming from a total of 36 different countries from all over the world.

II. Human Resource Development

The University recognizes the need to develop its human resource in terms of qualifications and skills to meet the demands of its stakeholders. For year 2005, there were 11 successful members for Master's Degree and 17 for Ph.D. In addition, 9 new applicants for Master's and 17 new applicants for Ph.D. scholarships were approved. A total of 87 faculty and staff members are presently pursuing their studies: 2 members taking Graduate Diploma in Teacher Education, 37 members taking Master's programs, 48 members taking Ph.D. programs. The Master's and Ph.D. programs are being taken in countries such as Thailand, Australia, USA, England and New Zealand.

For seminars, conferences and training programs, out of 364 faculty and staff participants, 56 attended various faculty development programs abroad and 308 nationally.

III. Research and Academic Presentations

In support for an academic's quest for new knowledge, in the year 2005, out of 4 research proposals 1 research was approved for funding. Final reports for the other researches that have been approved in 2004 academic year are also due this year-end.

Throughout the year, a total of 21 faculty members did academic presentations abroad and 16 members within the country.

IV. Academic Titles

For the year 2005, the University proudly acknowledged the achievement of 1 faculty member who has been appointed to the rank of Assistant Professors.

For this year's Au Awards for Excellence, the University takes great pleasure in conferring various awards for excellence on 11 outstanding faculty members and 19 deserving staff members.

1. St. Michael Award for Public Service

1.1 Mr. Artit Pinpak

Awarded St. Michael Award for Public Service (Third Class)

Citation:

Mr. Artit Pinpak is an alumnus who took his LLB degree in 1996 and after securing his LLM in International Law from Chulalongkorn University, joined the Faculty of Law on June 1, 2001.

Awarded St. Michael Award for Public Service (Third Class)

Citation:

Dr. Noppadon Kannika joined the Ethics and Religious Research Centre as a full-time lecturer on November 1, 1991. He now has acquired two Bachelor's degrees, Philosophy and Political Science, two Master's degrees, Sociology and Survey Methodology, and a Doctoral degree in Computer and Engineering Management, which show that he has high educational ideals and continues to pursue courses and programs of study tirelessly.

In addition to his duties as Director of ABAC Poll Research Centre, Dr. Noppadon works for many government agencies such as the Ministry of Justice, Ministry of Social Development and Human Security, Ministry of Public Health, the Narcotic Control Board etc. He also specializes in surveys on consumer satisfaction with marketing strategies and evaluation research including surveys on crime and drug abuse.

He is represented on the ad hoc committee of the House of Representatives on statistical matters, acts as research expert on quality of Thai Youth at the Ministry of Education and is a consultant in the Immigration Department, Highway Police Department and the First Army Area of the Royal Thai Military.

2. St. Hilaire Award for Distinction in Writing

Citation:

Dr. Yusuf joined Assumption University in October 2000 and before that he had served as "Visiting Specialist in Islamic Studies" at Prince of Songkla University

from 1994-2000 and Mahidol University from 1991-1994 respectively. It is observed that in addition to his work as head of the religious studies in the Graduate School, Dr. Yusuf has been writing and editing books and articles, some of which are cited below.

Citation:

Dr. Patricia Arttachariya joined the teaching profession in June 1978 and she is therefore a doyen of the Assumption University faculty corps. Although at the prime of her career, at the height of her responsibilities and in spite of numerous duties she managed to go back to school and secure a Ph.D. in Industrial and Business Studies from University of Warwick, in 1997 demonstrating that one can still be sprightly and intellectually active provided there is the indomitable will and strength of purpose.

He pursued further studies at the Graduate School of Business and at De La Salle University, Philippines and secured the MBA and DBA degrees in 1991 and 1998 respectively on scholarships awarded by Assumption University.

Dr. Ismail is the coordinator for finance related subjects of the Graduate School of Business and co-chairperson of the Thesis Committee. He has been a regular resource person for the Continuing Education Centre of the Asian Institute of Technology since 1998 and a recipient of many accolades and certificates of recognition from the management of this renowned institution.

Dr. Ismail is also a regular lecturer in the advanced management and mini-MBA programs for senior executives organised by the Business Training and Consultancy Centre of Assumption University. The trainees under these programs included officials from such organizations as Bangkok General Hospital, Siriraj Hospital, Professional Services Co., Ltd., Caltex Thailand, etc.

Dr. Ismail often takes a didactic approach to life and while he mixes freely with students and fellow teachers, he is always cordial and courteous, ready with advice and suggestions to help in solving tutorial problems and other pedagogic matters relating to courses of study etc.

3.3 Assistant Professor Dr. Teay Shawyun

Citation:

Dr. Teay Shawyun was first appointed as lecturer in April 1984 but he left in December 1999. He rejoined as Deputy Director, Centre for Excellence from May 1, 2003 and now he also holds the position of Program Director in the College of Internet Distance Education. He is an alumnus of Assumption University, having taken the B.B.A., Business Computer (Suma Cum Laude) in 1982, then studied for and acquired MBA from Sasin Graduate Institute, Chulalongkorn University in 1985 and Ph.D. from Asian Institute of Technology in 1996.

After rejoining Assumption University, Asst. Prof. Dr. Teay developed the AuQS 2000 CQM (Curriculum Quality Management) in October 2005 and revamped the QA web to be more attractive and to serve as the key medium to disseminate QA information and also started the quarterly Q.A. Newsletter.

Asst. Prof. Dr. Teay also rendered valuable services to other institutions. He was invited by University of South Australia to be external examiner for the Doctor of Business Administration dissertations. He provided training on Strategy and Organization Change for "Business Leadership in an Uncertain Environment" at AIT Extension Program as well as delivered lectures on "Supervisory Skills" under AIT and World Food Program of UN in Phnom Penh, Cambodia.

His part-time teachings as invited lecturers include Thammasat University on Marketing Information System from 1996, Burapha University on Marketing Management and Business Plan from September 2000, Mahidol University on Management Information System in 2002, Payap University on MIS and Strategic Management from 2002.

Ms. Aussama Soontrunnarunungsi joined the Faculty of Biotechnology in June, 2002 after obtaining her BS. and M.S. in Agro-Industrial Product Development from Kasetsart University in 1999 and 2002 respectively.

Although a newcomer to the institution, Ms. Aussama is very keen and highly devoted to food technology both as a hobby and as a profession. Some of the projects being undertaken and in which she is deeply involved are as follows.

Mrs. Him-Yock joined the Department of English, Faculty of Arts on November 1, 1986 and has therefore served without interruption for nearly two decades. She has held the position of a Deputy Chairperson from June 1, 1992 to March 31, 1994 and again from October 1, 1997 to date and her credentials are found to be spotless and clean in spite of her heavy responsibilities.
