## ABSTRACT

Because of such gap in protection may cause the illegal conduct by using such gap to gain benefit, or cause the negligence in storage such information in private sectors and may cause the bad effects to owner of such information.

Due to the fact that Thailand still has no law to protect personal information in private sector possessed directly. Necessary to economic and social, and for benefit in international business, so Thailand should enacts Personal Information Protection Act in private sector possessed. An idea to draft this Act become figure since B.E. 2540, but until now the drafted of such Act is still in process.

As I mentioned, Thailand still has many problems about personal information infringement.
